ANNOUNCEMENT ON IMPLEMENTING DIFFERENTIATED EXPRESSWAY TOLL FOR FREIGHT VEHICLES IN SICHUAN PROVINCE

This announcement is made on a voluntary basis by Chengdu Expressway Co., Ltd. (the "**Company**", together with its subsidiaries, the "**Group**").

The Company recently received the Notice on Implementing Differentiated Expressway Toll for Freight Vehicles (《關於實施高速公路差異化收費的通知》) jointly issued by the Department of Transportation of Sichuan Province, Sichuan Provincial Development and Reform Commission and Finance Department of Sichuan Province, pursuant to which, commencing from April 1, 2019, Sichuan Province will implement differentiated toll for the normally loaded and legitimately transporting weight-based-tolling freight vehicles. Details are as follows:

I. DIFFERENTIATED TOLL OF "LINEAR REDUCTION BASED ON INCREASING DISTANCE" FOR ORDINARY FREIGHT VEHICLES

III. DISCOUNT FOR ETC CARD PAYMENT BY FREIGHT VEHICLES

Implementation mode:	5% discount on the total amount of weight-based expressway toll for freight vehicles that pay through the ETC card of Sichuan Province
Implementation scope:	expressway network in Sichuan Province.
Implementation period:	April 1, 2019 to March 31, 2024.

According to the preliminary estimate and analysis by the Group, the above-mentioned policy will reduce the toll revenue from freight traffic of the Group's expressways to a certain extent, but it may also attract parts of the freight vehicles transporting on some other expressways or highways that have not implemented this preferential policy to pass through the expressways of the Group. Meanwhile, as the proportion of passenger traffic volumn of the expressways operated by the Group to total traffic volume exceeds 80%, and the proportion of freight traffic volumn to total traffic volume is less than 20%, it is therefore expected that the above-mentioned policy on differentiated toll for freight vehicles will not have any material effect on the operation and performance of the Group.
